

ADDENDUM # 2 TO
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING SIGNED ON JULY 4TH, 2017
BETWEEN
THE COLLEGE OF INTERDISCIPLINARY STUDIES
THAMMASAT UNIVERSITY, THAILAND
AND
THE COLLEGE OF SOCIAL SCIENCES
NATIONAL CHENGCHI UNIVERSITY, TAIWAN, R.O.C.

With the purpose to reinforce and substantiate the cooperation relationship, enhance the variety, and regulate scholar exchange between the College of Interdisciplinary Studies, Thammasat University (hereafter, CIS-TU) and the College of Social Sciences, National Chengchi University (hereafter, CSS-NCCU), both parties agree to conduct Addendum # 2 to Memorandum of Understanding signed on July 4th, 2017 (hereafter, Addendum # 2). The details are stipulated as follows:

1. Number of Scholar Exchange

One from each side

2. Duration of Stay at Host University

10 to 14 days. Month and date are negotiable but must begin before 31 December 2018.

3. Activities during a stay at host university

- Participations in academic activities at the host institution
- Field research or self-study

4. Financial Responsibilities


For a TU scholar going to NCCU, CIS-TU will be financially responsible for an air ticket (Bangkok-Taipei-Bangkok) and accommodation, and CSS-NCCU will be responsible for providing TU scholar with administrative assistance in finding on/off-campus accommodation, acquiring access to NCCU libraries and WiFi network, and arranging research space upon TU scholar's request and space availability at NCCU. Upon request, CSS-NCCU may make an arrangement for a TU scholar to visit institutions or organizations in Taiwan. In any case, a TU scholar will be responsible for his/her travel, medical, and all other expenses in while staying in Taiwan.

For an NCCU scholar going to TU, CSS-NCCU will be financially responsible for an air ticket (Taipei-Bangkok-Taipei) and accommodation, and CIS-TU will be responsible for providing NCCU scholar with administrative assistance in finding on/off-campus accommodation, acquiring access to TU libraries and WiFi network, and arranging research space upon NCCU scholar's request and space availability at TU. Upon request, CIS-TU may make an arrangement for an NCCU scholar to visit institutions or organizations in Thailand. In any case, an NCCU scholar will be responsible for his/her travel, medical, and all other expenses in while staying in Thailand.

5. Period of Agreement

Addendum # 2 will enter into force upon signing by the representatives of both parties and be effective for the calendar year of 2018. It is written in English and executed in duplicate; each party will retain one original copy.


